Definitions

- EPD** - Expected Progeny Difference - How calves are expected to perform based on parents and other offspring
- CED** - Calving Ease Direct - Greater than 10 could be used on heifers
- BW EPD** - Birth Weight EPD - The lower the number the easier calving
- WN Adj. WT** - Weaning Adjusted Weight - The weaning weights adjusted to 205 days of age
- WW EPD** - Weaning Weight EPD - The higher the EPD the heavier their calves should be at weaning
- YW EPD** - Yearling Weight EPD - The higher the EPD the heavier their calves should be at a year of age
- DOC EPD** - Docility EPD - The higher the number the more docile the bull should be
- Milk EPD** - The higher the EPD the more milk the female should produce
- Marb EPD** - Marbling EPD - The higher the EPD the more marbling the bull should have
- RE EPD** - Ribeye Area EPD - The higher the number the bigger the ribeye should be
- COG Rank** - Cost of Gain Rank - The lower the number the more feed efficient the bull is
- Adj. F:G** - Adjusted Feed to Gain - The amount of feed it takes for the bull to gain one pound
- Test ADG** - Test Average Daily Gain - The higher the number the more the bull gained per day
